How do they talk to the children? Do they listen well? Background Experience? Discipline?



Physical Environment

Is it safe? (Ex: electrical sockets covered) Is it clean?

Is there enough room?

Appearance of inside/outside equipment? Meals/Snacks?

Where do they nap?

First Aid Kit?

Contact in case of emergency?

Evacuation Procedures?

Bathroom?

Heaters?

Yard?

What am I responsible for bringing?

Atmosphere

Activities/services provided?
Have I made my expectations clear
to the child care provider?
Do I understand the child care provider's
expectations?

Social Interaction

How do the children relate to each other?

Will your child fit in with the other children?

Are the language and culture of each child respected?

Emotional

How children act? (Ex happy, sad, relaxed)

Do they seem to trust the child care provider?

Do they communicate well with the child care provider?

Do you feel comfortable?

Additional Concerns

Have we agreed on the due dates and amounts of payment fees? Have we agreed on advance notice if child will be absent or late?
